Béatrice Dumont is Professor of economics at the University Sorbonne Paris Nord. She is also the Director of the Department of Economics and Jan Tinbergen Professor for European Economics at the College of Europe. Between 2006 and 2009, she was a member of the prospective unit of the French Prime Minister on intellectual property rights (IPRs). She was a visiting research fellow at the University of Chicago and MERIT, Maastricht University in The Netherlands.
